

Action Leadership Retreat

Designed for educators with 18-36 months experience, the Action Leadership Retreat consists of opportunities to participate in simulated on-the-job experiences. It is designed to help you evaluate your performance at some of the more advanced skills needed to become a successful Extension professional. The kinds of skills to be assessed will be: conflict management, team building, use of Extension policies and procedures, volunteer development, program development, and leadership. The activities will be based on realistic county-based situations that are applicable regardless of program area. This is a program which has been developed by your peers, and will involve a combination of observation and self-assessment. The confidential results will be used to assist you in planning for future developmental experiences.
